And whereas the trustees described in point no. g to i have resigned from the trust voluntary vide their resignation letter and affidavits duly accepted in resolution dt. 09<sup>th</sup> April 2024.

AND WHEREAS the Trustees have agreed to get the said alteration registered as Amendment to the original trust deed no. 892, date 07-07-09 and amendment trust deed no. 4032, date 27-02-2020 with Sub.Registrar Adampur.

And Whereas the Trustees have agreed to carry out the Trust herein created.

Now it is hereby agreed as follows: -

1. That this Amendment replacing the trustees shall form an integral part of the original trust deed and shall be attached to the original deed.
2. That now onwards the Trust shall have three founders as under:
  1. Bhoop Singh
  2. Parmod
  3. AjayThese Founders shall also be initial Trustees of the Trust and shall remain Trustees during their lifetime. They are also authorized to nominate any person to become trustee at the time of their death and so on.
3. That in order to become new trustee Sh. Avit Kumar, Sh. Sushil, Sh. Sandeep has contributed a fund of Rs. 5100/- each towards corpus of the trust to be used for the objectives of the trust.
4. That the name of the Trust shall be **GURU DRONACHARYA EDUCATIONAL TRUST** and its office shall, for the present, be situated at **GURU DRONACHARYA INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL, Near Railway Bridge, Siswal Road, Adampur, Tehsil Adampur, District Hisar – 125052.**

3. VISION:

4. MISSION:

5. CONDITIONS:

The Trust shall be always bound by the following conditions:

- (a) The income and property of the trust shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the trust as set forth in the Memorandum of trust and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, to the members of the Trust
- (b) No salary will be given to the members of the trust for being member. However, he shall be re-imbursed for the out-pocket expenses and interest on money lent or rent for premises /demises to the Trust and working in the trust in any other capacity. However, in any case payment made to him shall be reasonable and at par with the other personnel/ staff.
- (c) The Trust by its constitution is required to apply its profit, if any, or others income in promoting its objects.
- (d) If upon the winding-up dissolution of the Trust, there remains after satisfaction of all its debits liabilities any property whatsoever the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Trust, but shall be given or transferred to some others institution having objects similar to the objects of the trust to determined by the members of the trust at or before the time of dissolution.
- (e) The founder members shall also be initial trustees of the trust and shall remain trustee during his/ their lifetime and after his/their death any male or female members of his/her family to whom he/she nominate at the time of his/their death shall become co- trustee and so on.

6. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:

- To establish and provide Education Centers/School/Institutions for Formal/ Non-Formal Education, School Education/Training, Computer education, Education in Engineering, Medical Education, Education in Business Management & Law etc.

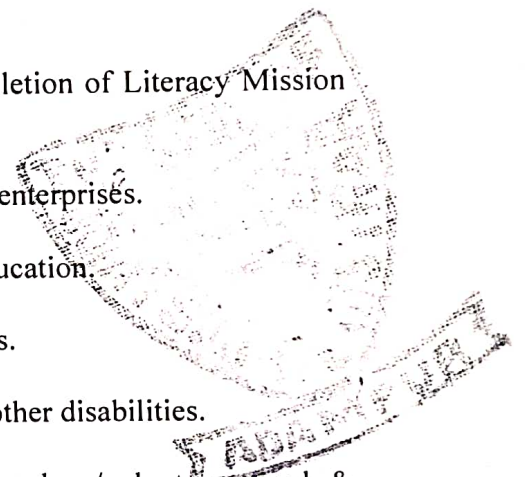

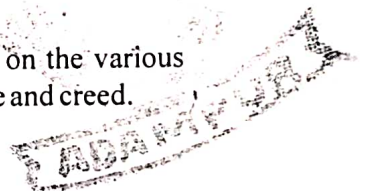



# CONSTITUTION OF GURU DRONACHARYA EDUCATIONAL TRUST

## (RULES AND REGULATIONS)

### 1. NAME:

The name of the trust shall be GURU DRONACHARYA EDUCATIONAL TRUST.

- (a) Trust means the GURU DRONACHARYA EDUCATIONAL TRUST.
- (b) "Member" means any person having been admitted as a member of the trust according to its rules and regulations and it means a member of General Body of the trust.
- (c) "Founder Member means any member who have subscribed the memorandum of Association of the Trust as first members of the Executive Committee. Any other member of the General Body may be conferred the status equivalent to that of a founder member for all intents and purposes of the Trust by the secret voting among the founder members. Such elected member will be known as "elected equivalent to founder member" and will defined under the category of founder member of the trust. No founder member of the Trust will be absent from such election and single negative vote of any founder member will debar the proposed elected equivalent to founder member from election. No such election can be held without twenty days prior notice to this effect to all founder members.
- (d) "Office bearers" means that President, Vice President, General Secretary & Treasurer or any other post(s), in-charge(s) of the sub-committee/special committee created by the Executive Committee.
- (e) "Executive Members, means the member of the Executive Committee.
- (f) "General body" shall be comprised of all the members of trust including the Honorary members, Founder members and Executive Committee members.

### 2. Funds:

The trust will be authorized to raise funds and manage movable and immovable property.

- (a) The trust shall collect funds though voluntary subscriptions, donations, gifts, subsidies, incentives and endowment, government grants or grants from other bodies interested in the activities of the trust. It shall acquire buildings or land for the aims and objectives stated in the memorandum of Association, relating the power to sell, mortgage or dispose of these properties in any way deemed fit by it.

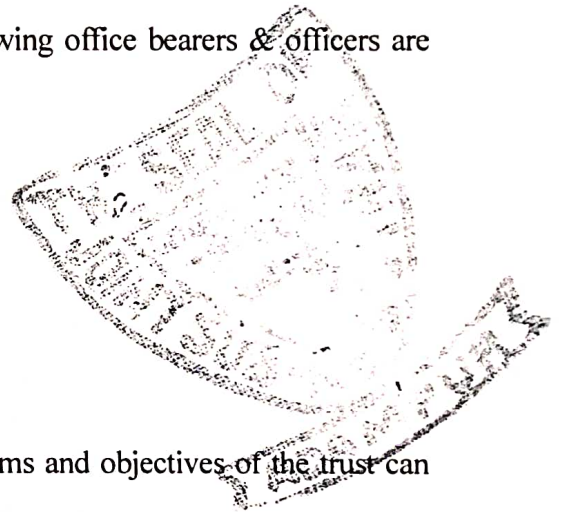
- (b) The trust shall purchase necessary equipment and/or receive it as gifts or donations.
- (c) The Association shall ask for and accept loans from Govt. would itself raise loans from other sources.

### 3. Accounts:

The financial year of the trust shall be from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 31<sup>st</sup> March each year. Its accounts will be operated as follows: -

- (a) All the memory shall kept in a scheduled Bank as will be convenient for the trust to operate. The General Secretary and the Treasurer will on behalf of the trust jointly operate the account.
- (b) The Treasurer shall prepare in proper in proper format the Receipt & Payments, Income and Expenditure as well as the Assists and Liability statements. The Executive Committee before submission to the auditor shall approve the accounts. The Executive Committee shall present the duly audited accounts to the Annual General Meeting.
- (c) In the interest of trust & as per need of hour, following office bearers & officers are authorized to sanction fund at a time:

### 4. Membership:

Any individual person and/or bodies concurring with the aims and objectives of the trust can become member(s) of the trust provided:

- He is a major (over 18 years)
- He is of sound mind, gently and well behaved and is in the opinion of the majority of the existing members, interested in aims & objectives of the trust thoroughly fit to be enrolled as member. No bar of caste, creed & religion.
- He is not convicted by a court of law for offences involving moral turpitude or declared as insolvent.
- He pays the admission fee of Rs. 300/- and the annual subscription of Rs. 300/- membership fees shall not be refundable in any circumstance. The membership fees and the annual fees may be changed or varied as deemed appropriate by the Executive Committee of the Trust from time to time.

- Any eminent person or doner of one lakh or more money having interest in the objective of the trust may become a patron of the trust.

**Termination of membership:**

Membership of the trust shall cease under the following circumstances: -

- (a) If he/she Act against Aims & objectives of the trust
- (b) Upon death or resignation.
- (c) If the majority of the existing members at any time consider his membership harmful to the interest of the trust.
- (d) Insolvency or physical and mental disability.
- (e) Failure to pay dues of the trust in time.
- (f) Work against Absent in Continuously three meetings.

**Powers and functions of the General Body: -**

- (a) All enrolled members shall constitute the general body. Its main function shall be to contribute to the cause of & promote the aims and objectives of the trust. All powers in the administration of the trust and the constitution of the Executive Committee shall rest in the General Body.
- (b) The General Body will elect a committee of the persons from among its members to be called the Executive committee/Executive Body for two years. The election will be by direct system by appointing an Electoral Officer by the General Body.
- (c) The General Secretary shall maintain a register of members. Only such embers would be authorized to vote in the election to Executive Committee as have cleared all their dues to the trust.
- (d) The General Body shall meet once ina year to analyze & pass work done by the Executive Body. But on need, President/General Secretary may call meeting of the General Body.
- (e) The time, date and place of general Body meeting shall be decided by the President to be communicated to every member by the General Secretary, at least ten days before the meeting.
- (f) The Quorum of the General Body meeting will be of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> member of the total. In the absence of Quorum, meeting will be postponed and will be called at fixed time & place. Then, there will be no need of Quorum. While Agenda will be the same.
- (g) The General Body will appoint Executive Director.

- (h) Non-confidence motion against the Executive committee shall be only if a resolution to this effect is signed by at least half of the total membership.

## 5. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE;

Subject to the overall and over-riding control and supervision of the General Body. The day to day affairs of the Trust shall be managed by the Executive Committee, which shall comprise of:

- President
- Vice President
- General secretary
- Treasurer

Unless otherwise determined by the members in the General Body Meeting, the total number of members or the Executive Committee shall not be less than 4 and more than 11, inclusive of the four office bearers and at least one founder member will the members of the Executive Committee except for the purpose of voting. The voting rights can also be conferred on them by the Executive Committee itself for any number of meetings of the Executive Committee.

The first term of the Executive Committee shall be for a period of three years and thereafter each term will be for a period of three years. In case of any vacancy, it will be filled by the remaining members of the Executive Committee for the remaining tenure of the Executive Committee.

Initially the numbers of Executive Committee members are four who are the first members of the trust. The tenure of this Executive Committee is fixed three years from the date of registration of the trust and in case the Executive Committee of the General Body decides to make more members of the executive Committee then this can be done by electing any number of members from General Body of the Trust keeping in view the above discussed strength of the Trust.

## 6. POWER OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

The Executive Committee will have following rights & duties, which will perform in direction & Consultation with the Executive Director:

- Enroll members & terminate them
- Prepare property of the trust
- Form sub-committee for systematic working
- Manage the affairs of trust and other institutions run by it.

## 7. QUORUM OF MEETING:

The meeting shall be considered valid if at least 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of the members are present in the meeting where matters shall be decided by majority votes. The committee shall meet at least twice a year. The time, place and date of the meeting shall be decided by the President, In absence of Quorum, meeting will be postponed & further day will be at fixed place & time The agenda will be the same. Minimum two office bearers are required in addition to members. The proceeding will be passed in next meeting. Information about meeting will be communicated by the General Secretary 3 days prior to meeting to each member. Urgent meeting information can be communicated before some time of meeting.

## 8. POWERS OF OFFICER BEARERS & OFFICER IN CHARGE:

### I President

- (a) He will preside over all the meetings of the General Body, Executive Committee. In his absence the Vice-President shall deputes for him.
- (b) He will represent the trust.
- (c) The President shall exercise casting vote in case of a tie.
- (d) He will call urgent meetings at the request of members as per rules.
- (e) The President shall have the power, in an emergency which in his opinion requires immediate action, to take such action as he may deem necessary. He shall report the action so taken to the Executive Committee and have ratified it in its next meeting.
- (f) The President may fill the vacancy by nominating another member of the Executive Committee in case of a vacancy of an office bearer during the term, till a new office bearer is elected by the Executive Committee for the remaining period of the term of such office.

### II Vice-President

- a) In the absence of the President, the Vice-President shall deputes for him carry on at the functions normally done by the President. In the absence of senior, Vice-President will deputes for him carry on all the functions normally done by the President.

### III General Secretary:

- (a) he shall issue notices with the permission of the president to call meetings of the General Body and Executive Committee.
- (b) He will record and maintain the proceedings of the General Body and managing committee meetings and will execute the resolution passed at these meetings.
- (c) He will maintain the records of the trust and will issue cheques for payments of bills. He will also control the income and expenditure.
- (d) He will carry on correspondence with different departments.
- (e) To keep a register of General body members with their complete addresses.
- (f) To sign records and documents for execution of works, programmes and plans as may be decided by the Executive Committee.
- (g) In the event of winding up of the trust the General Secretary with the sanction of the Chairman and a member of the Executive Committee shall dissolve the trust shoes properties shall then be disposed of to pay for the debts and liabilities in order of preference. Any balance amount remaining thereof shall be donated to a trust of a like nature.

### IV Treasurer:

- a) He will keep accounts of the trust in proper order.
- b) He will prepare in proper format the Annual Account Statements comprising income & Expenditure, Receipt & Payments, Liability & Assets.
- c) He will control the daily accounts & record it.
- d) He will provide receipt for donation, & grant in aid.
- e) He will perform other duties as provided by the Executive Committee.

### V Public Relation Officer (If appointed):

- (a) He will popularize the activities of the trust.
- (b) He will develop better understanding/relation among Govt. Trust & General Masses.

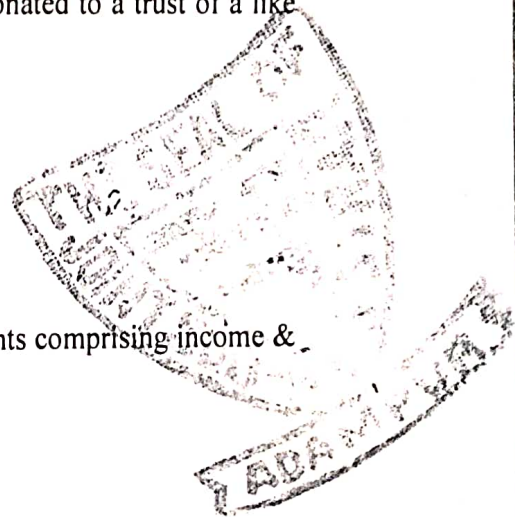

## 9. Audit

- (a) The Managing Committee, with the approval of the General Body, may frame rules and regulations for transaction of business of the institution run by the trust including the service conditions of the trust.
- (b) The accounts shall be got audited every year from a Chartered Accountant and the report placed for inspection by the member of the trust.
- (c) The record of the accounts of the trust shall be kept for a minimum period of five years. Therefore, the record shall be destroyed by burning in the presence members of the Managing Committee.

## 10. Amendment/Change in Rules:

Any addition, alteration, modification or deletion in the existing Memorandum of Trust, Rule and Regulations of the Trust shall be made by a resolution passed by 2/3<sup>rd</sup> majority of the members present and voting in the Executive Committee and thereafter be approved by simple majority of the members present and voting in specially convened meeting of the General Body of the Trust for the purpose.

## 11. Record of the Trust:

The minute's book, account books, membership register and stock register would be kept at the registered office of the trust.


## 12. Dissolution of trust:


The trust shall stand dissolved when it fails to work for the purpose it has been brought about. The same with the sanction of the President and a member of the Executive Committee shall declare the trust as dissolved and the properties sold in a manner to get maximum prices in order to clear the debts and liabilities of the trust, the balance, if any of the properties shall be donated to a trust for their personal benefit.

In case of non-clarification of any of the provisions in the deed, provisions of general law or law applicable to charitable societies registered under Societies Registration Act, 1860 as applicable to the State of Haryana shall apply to trust.




